Tree Reduction For Metrobus Depot in Crawley, West Sussex

Tree Marshalls Ltd reduced trees at Metrobus's Crawley depot to ensure clearance from hydrogen storage areas. Our arborists developed site-specific Risk Assessment Method Statements (RAMS) to address safety hazards. Using a tracked cherry picker with a 20-meter height and 9.7-meter outreach, acquired in early 2021, we operated efficiently and safely. The work was executed with great care, avoiding damage to pipes or equipment. Metrobus was very satisfied with the results, highlighting our team's thorough approach.
