## Roffey Park, Horsham

Tree Marshalls Ltd successfully tackled the removal of a dead western red cedar and a dead red oak. Due to the trees' unstable condition, a Unimog with a Hiab was brought in to handle large sections of deadwood.

Lead climber Adam worked using the cherry picker to ensure his safety. Precise placement of lifting straps on the tree was vital to gain the safest possible manoeuvres. Branches were chipped on-site, and logs were removed for biomass. Another safe and efficient operation by Tree Marshalls Ltd.

## Wentworth Estate, Virginia Water

Tree Marshalls Ltd recently led a successful operation to remove a hazardous beech tree lodged within another tree, demonstrating expert planning and cost management by skilled arborists. The project utilized a 60-ton crane, heavy-duty track mats to protect the driveway, and a strategic rigging system to stabilize the tree.

Preparatory work, including clearing rhododendron and setting up equipment, helped avoid costly overtime crane charges. The operation concluded with the safe lifting and removal of large tree sections, followed by restoring the site to its original condition.

This project underscores the importance of safety-focused planning and efficient resource use in complex tree removals.
